Standard Chartered Hong Kong to resume normal branch operating hours

9 April 2021, Hong Kong – Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (“Standard Chartered Hong Kong”) announced that all its branches*, Priority Banking Centres, Priority Private Centre and Corporate Express Centres will resume normal operating hours with effect from 12 April 2021 (Monday):

To ensure the health and safety of clients and employees, infection control measures will continue to be in place including temperature check and mandatory wearing of masks inside the branches. Clients can use Online Banking, SC Mobile App or Phone Banking services to help reduce the flow of people at the branches. The Bank will continue to monitor the situation closely and consider further adjustments to the branch operations as necessary.
