Standard Chartered Hong Kong branches to be temporarily closed on Saturday in response to the latest pandemic situation

23 February 2022, Hong Kong – In light of the rapidly evolving epidemic situation in Hong Kong, in order to safeguard the health and safety of our clients and employees while maintaining the availability of its banking services, Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (“Standard Chartered Hong Kong”) announces that effective 26 February, its bank branches, Priority Banking Centres and Priority Private Centre will be temporarily closed on Saturday until further notice.
