Standard Chartered alerts customers of phishing SMS and fraudulent website

10 March 2021, Hong Kong – Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (the “Bank”) would like to alert its clients and the public of a case of phishing SMS with a link to a fraudulent Standard Chartered website which requests clients to provide their user name and password. Below are the screenshot of the fraudulent website and phishing SMS:
