Standard Chartered adjusts Hong Kong branch operations in response to the coronavirus

31 January 2020, Hong Kong – In view of the latest developments of the novel coronavirus with consideration to ensuring the health and safety of clients and employees and maintaining the availability of its banking services, Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (“Standard Chartered Hong Kong”) announced today an adjustment to its branch operations until further notice.
