FPS via New SC Pay available for real-time inter-bank and P2P transfers Download the latest version of SC Mobile to try out the new function

17 September 2018, Hong Kong – Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (“Standard Chartered Hong Kong”) empowers its mobile banking, Standard Chartered Mobile Banking (“SC Mobile”), with another new function - SC Pay, which allows clients to enjoy the convenience of real-time inter-bank and P2P (person-to-person) transfers via the Faster Payment System (FPS). From now on, clients are able to send money instantly for free in HKD or RMB of value up to HKD10,000 or equivalent, using SC Mobile with either a mobile number, email address or merchant ID. To ensure clients are familiarised with the Bank’s digital services, 40 Digital Ambassadors will be deployed to the branches at key locations to promote SC Pay and help clients register for this new service.

Register for SC Pay


Clients can download the latest version of SC Mobile and register for SC Pay by binding their Standard Chartered Bank account to the mobile number or email address as registered with the Bank. From 30 September 2018 onwards, clients can send money to their friends instantly using their mobile number or email address, or pay the merchants via their merchant ID and enjoy the convenience of making 24x7 instant transfers.

It only takes 3 simple steps to register for SC Pay on SC Mobile:

1. Tap "SC Pay" and log in to SC Mobile



2. Confirm the details, and set Standard Chartered bank account as the default bank account for fund transfer



3. Key in One-Time Password (OTP) to authenticate the registration
