## Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2024 returns with 74,000-runner quota

*Hosting the Asian Marathon Championships  
Launching 'Mr. & Ms. Super Thousand' special award again for local runners*

**HONG KONG, 30 August 2023** – The Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2024 (“SCHKM 2024”), which will be held on 21 January (Sunday) next year, returns as a full-scale event with the overall runner quota being raised to 74,000. Online registration ([www.hkmarathon.com](http://www.hkmarathon.com)) for the various race categories will commence in phases from 31 August; the public ballot (including the re-introduced 10km team race) will officially start at 10am on 21 September.

The internationally-renowned event is further boosted with the addition of the Asian Marathon Championships, which it hosts for the fifth time, affirming Hong Kong's status as a centre for major international sports event. Top runners from nearly 45 Asian countries and regions will be invited to compete in Hong Kong.

### **'Mr. & Ms. Super Thousand' special award**

In celebration of the 25th edition of the race earlier this year, the Marathon Special Incentive Award was upgraded which was the talk of the town and gave rise to a record of over 200 'Mr. and Ms. Super Thousand'. With the hosting of the Asian Marathon Champions at the SCHKM 2024, the Marathon Special Incentive Award is upgraded again to encourage local runners to compete and challenge themselves alongside the Asian top athletes in this rare opportunity. Permanent Hong Kong residents finishing the marathon race under 3 hours (sub 3) for men or under 3 hours 30 minutes for women (sub 3:30) will each be offered the special prize money of HKD 10,000.

**Mr. Kwan Kee, Chairman of Hong Kong, China Association of Athletics Affiliates (HKAAA)** said, “The Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon is the leading annual event for Hong Kong citizens to enjoy running. We thank the HKSAR Government and all sponsors for their support, and in particular our title sponsor Standard Chartered Hong Kong for its dedicated support for more than 25 years. We also express our gratitude to all volunteers, runners and Hong Kong citizens for making the events possible.”

There will be five event categories which include the Marathon, Half-Marathon, 10km, 10km Wheelchair Race and Wheelchair Trial (2.5km). Both the Marathon and Half Marathon will start from Nathan Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, the 10km races will begin at the Island Eastern Corridor, while the Wheelchair Races will start from Wan Chai Sports Ground. All races will finish at the Victoria Park.
